Welcome, agenda reading:

The agenda was not amended.

<u>Act 40 – Diplomacy Act 2017</u> (Emperor Adam I, Prince Jake):

The Emperor proposed the Act. Sir Reginald Hall asked for clarification as to the difference between macronations and micronations. The Emperor explained the difference. Sir Paul McKenna asked for clarification that the nations recognised by the proposed Act had not been previously recognised. The Emperor confirmed that this was the case. The Council divided:

AYES: 6 (Emperor Adam I, Prince Jake, Emperor Mother Jayne, Reginald Hall, Paul McKenna, Crown Prince Daniel (post-meeting))

NOES: 0

The Act was passed.

Misc. debate – Plenary (Emperor Adam I):

The Emperor gave a short speech recapping the legislation that had been passed during the term of IV Legislature. In his capacity as President of the Liberal Party, the Emperor announced the upcoming Liberal Party conference and proposed constitution, as well as the fact that Prince Jake was likely to be selected as the Liberal Party's first Prime Ministerial candidate and that a radical manifesto was due to be proposed. The Emperor challenged the other parties (i.e. Moderates and Labour) to run radical election campaigns of their own. The leaders of the other parties declined to comment.

Any Other Business:

The Cabinet held its monthly meeting on the authority of the Prime Minister.
