Miscellaneous debates – Next steps following the cancelled general election (Lord James Green):

The Emperor explained that his intended next steps were the creation of a unicameral legislature, effectively abolishing the House of Citizens and creating a reduced number of directly-elected positions in the Ruling Council, whilst also reducing provincial representation on the Council to one member per province. There was broad agreement with this plan, but there was no consensus on the question of whether or not the Prime Minister would be directly elected as they were prior to 2019, or whether they would be nominated by the Ruling Council, and this question was deferred.

Any Other Business:

There was a procedural motion to ask the Emperor to buy a round of Jagerbombs for all present members; this was passed unanimously, and the Emperor did so.
